CONFIRMATION CLASS OF 2012

That time of the year has again arrived when our Eighth grade students begin studying toward the Rite of

Confirmation. This is a wonderful time in a student's life, when beliefs, Biblical truths and the life of the church is examined. With the assistance of Dave Roalef, myself and mentors their identity within the church is confirmed. The Rite of Confirmation is the public act of the students declaring that they confirm what their parents did for them in baptism. It is intended that those baptized will *confirm* the Church's action on their own behalf through *Confirmation*. It is publically accepting the responsibility – at the age of reason, willfully, and determinedly, to be a disciple of Christ.

The United Church of Christ has a little booklet Church Membership & You: What it means Today, which uses material from "The Church's Life" by Hazelton & Moss; "Confirmation and the United Church of Curriculum" by G.E. Tymeson; and the United Church Press © 1965 which defines it as a Rite marking the response in faith of a baptized person. There is no new life in Christ, no mission in the world, unless there is personal acceptance of commitment to God through Christ. To know or to accept God's love, His forgiveness, the gift of Christ and His Spirit, without creative, motivating gratitude is to fail Him, and one's self - - and to be imprisoned by blind selfishness! But to respond in faith and gratitude and to make covenant with Him to worship, praise and serve Him as one of God's own people is to make Confirmation!

Confirmation is a time honored rite that completes the process of initiation into the Christian life and the Church – but is still just at the beginning of a young person's Christian pilgrimage which will last throughout their life. They have been trained and equipped to go into the world and continue to grow in their Christian faith.

In many Christian Churches the Rite of Confirmation is initiated normally by the laving on of hands and/or anointing for the purpose of bestowing the Gifts of the Holy Spirit. In others like ours, confirmation bestows full membership in the church upon the recipient. This year's class starts September 16th with the Rite of Confirmation bestowed on the class March 24th, 2013, Palm Sunday. Along with the class study during the Sunday School hour the young people will also be asking some of you to act as their mentors during this process.




