

Parking Lot! \$6,000 Pledged in Commitment as of June 3. 2013

We need a new parking lot! We currently have over a dozen holes growing larger and many cracks also growing and crumbling in the parking lot. We need your help!

Our church is embarking on a capital campaign to raise \$26,000 to re-pave and stripe the parking lot. Gary Etter has challenged us to match his \$1,000 donation and our endowment fund may contribute up to \$12,000, so we are off to a great start!

The parking lot is the first thing our community sees when they come to GOPCC, and that can make a good or bad impression of our church and preschool. And we all would like to drive and park on a clean, smooth surface.

We would love to have your financial commitment to raise the remaining \$14,000. At a time when it is difficult for us to even meet our tithing pledge, we need to prayerfully consider an additional gift to our church. Maybe you cannot pledge any more at this time. Can you organize and run a fundraiser? Please pray about this. And please, as always, pray for GOPCC and our commitment to serving God and His will for us, our congregation and serving the community.

Our capital campaign will run from June 1 -Sept 1, 2013. Only if we can get a commitment to meet our goal can we move forward

with our project before winter sets in. This campaign is in addition to our annual stewardship campaign. We still need to meet our operating budget! The letter will explain the different options you have to support us.
