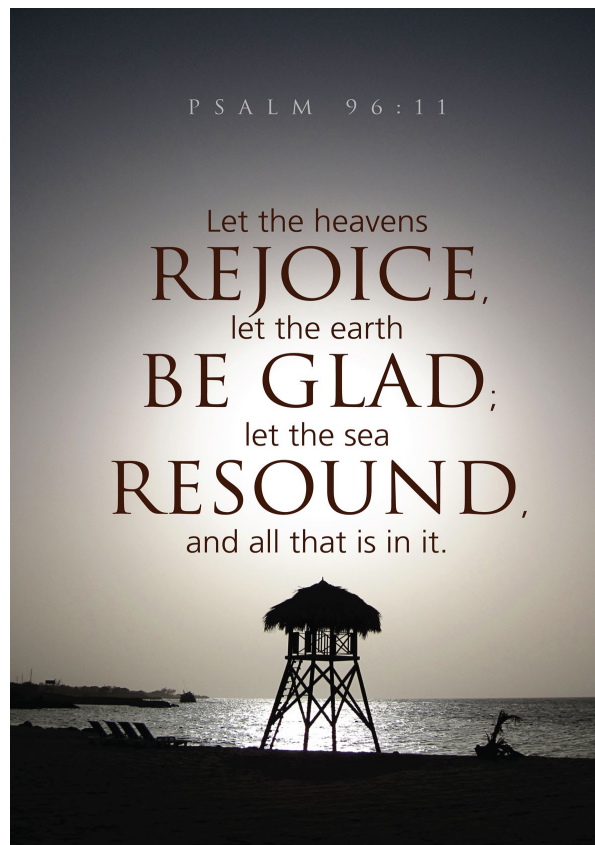
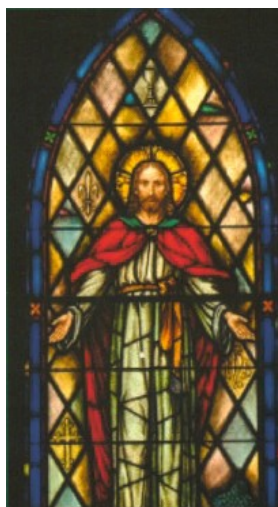
Church membership is based on the affirmation of the Biblical covenant:

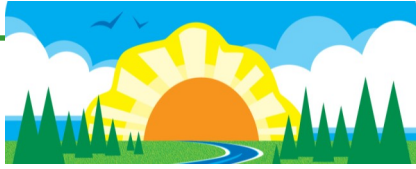

Looking for Pumpkin Patch Coordinators

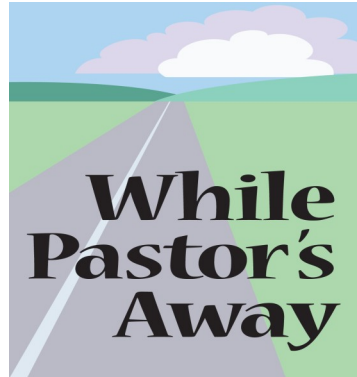
